

NEW ZEALAND DECLARATION

Any of the below statements are acceptable:

“I declare that: the goods described below are New Zealand originating goods as defined in Section 153ZIC of the Customs Act 1901 as they are wholly obtained in New Zealand, or New Zealand and Australia.”

“I declare that: the goods described below are New Zealand originating goods as defined in Section 153ZID of the Customs Act 1901 as they are produced entirely in New Zealand, or entirely in New Zealand and Australia, from originating materials only.”

“I declare that: the goods described below are New Zealand originating goods as defined in Section 153ZIE of the Customs Act 1901 as they are produced in New Zealand, or New Zealand and Australia, from non- originating materials.”

“I declare that: the goods described below are New Zealand originating goods as defined in Section 153ZIH of the Customs Act 1901 as they are wholly manufactured in New Zealand from unmanufactured raw products.”

“I declare that: The goods described below are New Zealand originating goods as described in Section 153ZIH of the Customs Act 1901 as they are wholly manufactured from materials wholly manufactured in Australia, or Australia and New Zealand, and also contain determined manufactured raw materials.”

“I declare that: The goods described below are New Zealand originating goods as described in Section 153ZIH of the Customs Act 1901 as they are wholly manufactured from materials wholly manufactured in Australia, or Australia and New Zealand, and do not contain determined manufactured raw materials.”
